

The Marion County Board of Supervisors met in special session at 3014 E Main St. Knoxville, IA 50138 on November 21, 2023 for the purpose of the Tier 2 Canvass of the votes from the November 7, 2023 City School Elections in Marion County, Iowa and adjacent jurisdictions. Present were Supervisor's Steve McCombs and Kisha Jahner. Supervisor Raymie was unable to attend.

Chairperson Jahner opened the special canvass at 10:31 A.M.

The results were presented including outside counties Tier 1 Canvass Summaries (Jasper and Mahaska) for multi-jurisdictional races from the November 7, 2023 City School Elections.

There were ties for a winner from the City School Elections Tier 1 Canvass due to 2 Write-In winners in the City of Hamilton Council At-Large race resigning their Write-In victories. The "next highest vote getters" in the race was a 5-way tie. The Board of Supervisors drew names "out of a hat" for the declared winners.


