## Permit Requirements for Building in Marion County

A Building Permit starts the building process in the unincorporated portions of Marion County. All new buildings, or expansion of existing buildings, require a Building Permit. When in doubt call the Zoning Office at 641-828-2243 or email <a href="mailto:mpoffenbarger@co.marion.ia.us">mpoffenbarger@co.marion.ia.us</a> to verify whether any permitting is required.

## For a new building on a property without a 911 address, an address will be generated as part of the Building Permit process.

All newly constructed homes or buildings with any type of waste water facilities are required to obtain a septic permit from the Marion County Environmental Health department. Reconnection to an existing septic system will require a review inspection and permit. All new homes are required to be wired by a certified electrician and inspected by the State of Iowa. Other electrical work may be done by homeowners but may require an inspection. The State website with the requirements is www.iowaelectrical.gov.

Marion County also advises to check with your mortgage lender and insurance company for any requirements they may have.

Contacting Marion County **BEFORE** you start building to find out the requirements will help the building process go more smoothly with less chance of delays.
